*1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the special regulations of the AYF and the rules of the Javelin class, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

*2 Alterations of Class Rules

The rules of the Javelin class will be altered as follows:

- 2.1 The Class Rules are as amended by the result of the ballot of boat owners conducted in June 2002, as per the constitution Part 1, Clause 11

*3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class where both helmsperson and crew are financial members of an affiliated Javelin Class Association.

All competitors are reminded that they must comply with ISAF Eligibility Code RRS Appendix 2.

International competitors are eligible to enter however they will not be eligible for the Australian Championship trophies.

- 3.2 All entries must show evidence of a boat's third party insurance cover of not less than **AUD\$5,000,000** for any one accident at this event.

***6 Measurements**

Spars and black bands
All sails

Any boat may be subject to a random measurement check or inspection. A boat notified of a measurement check or inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

***7 Sailing Instructions**

The Sailing Instructions will be available after 10:00 on Saturday 28TH Dec. 2002 at Perth Dinghy Sailing Club.

***8 Regatta Site**

The regatta site will be the Perth Dinghy Sailing Club , Hackett Drive, Crawley, W.A.

***9 Racing Area**

The racing area will be the waters of the Swan River, specifically the areas noted as Matilda Bay, and Melville Waters East, in close proximity to the Club.

***10 Courses**

The course shall be Windward / Leeward Courses as described in the sailing instructions.

***11 Sponsorship**

Bow numbers and Event sponsors' advertising may be required to be displayed on all competing boats. If so, adhesive signage will be provided and must be affixed to the forward third of the hull.

***12 Scoring**

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A.4.1 will apply.

***13 Radio Communications**

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.
